Jeff Jacobson moved to approve the agenda. Motion was seconded by Tyson Follman and approved by DeShawn Tofsrud, Randy Gunderson, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and Tyson Follman.

Tyson Follman moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of April 24 and May 1, 2019, meetings; list of bills; and April financial reports. Motion was seconded by Jeff Jacobson and approved by DeShawn Tofsrud, Randy Gunderson, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and Tyson Follman.

Ms. Follman requested that Close Up and Student Council Advisors be added to Extra-curricular schedule with a compensation of \$1000.00 a year for each position. Discussion was held. Jeff Jacobson moved to add Close-Up and HS Student Council Advisors to the extra-curricular schedule at \$1000.00 each and Elementary Student Council Advisor to the extra-curricular schedule at \$500.00. Motion was seconded by Kim Nelson and approved by DeShawn Tofsrud, Randy Gunderson, Jeff Jacobson, and Kim Nelsen. Tyson Follman abstained.

Tyson Follman moved to increase Mr. Roger Jensen's salary by \$1650.00 and Mr. Michael Silverman's salary by \$2000.00 for 2019-2020. Motion was seconded by Jeff Jacobson and approved by DeShawn Tofsrud, Randy Gunderson, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and Tyson Follman.

The Board read letter from Eugene Benner regarding house rent lease.

Mr. Jensen reported on the following: HS students who went to leadership conference will plant tree by Buddy Bench in memory of Evadean Baglien as service project; 10<sup>th</sup> grade students were give interest inventory and value sorter; 8<sup>th</sup> grade were give interest inventory; pre-school screening completed—approximately 5-6 students will be in pre-k 2019-2020; elementary math celebration; play day was May 8; registration for dual credit courses are in progress; elementary music concert is May 10; Senior Night is May 15; and grades k-6 will go to Minot Zoo at Roosevelt Park on May 22.

Jeff Jacobson moved to increase the classified base wages by \$0.50 an hour, including elementary art position. Motion was seconded by Kim Nelsen and approved by DeShawn Tofsrud, Randy Gunderson, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen. Tyson Follman abstained.

Mr. Silverman recommended purchasing a vehicle for drivers ed and staff travel. Mr. Silverman will research available vehicles and report to the Board.

Discussion was held on buses.

Mr. Silverman reported on Math applicant interviews; Wolford School District closing and Wolford Board meeting on May 21; and teacher appreciation week.

Tyson Follman moved to increase Business Manager Maria Dunlap's salary by \$1500.00 for 2019-2020. Motion was seconded by Jeff Jacobson and approved by DeShawn Tofsrud, Randy Gunderson, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and Tyson Follman.
