REGULAR BOARD MEETING
JUNE 18, 2018, 6:30 P.M.

UNOFFICIAL minutes of the Leeds Public School District Board, to be read and approved at the next regular meeting in March.

The 3-5 year public hearing was held in the Math room at 6:30 p.m. Present were Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Kim Nelsen, Jeff Jacobson, Maria Dunlap and Mr. Robert Bubach.

Mr. Bubach presented a Power Point presentation on the District's past and future demographics and finances.

At 7:00 p.m., the regular Board meeting was moved to the board room. Present were Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen, DeShawn Tofsrud, and Maria Dunlap, Business Manager. Absent were Elementary Principal, Roger Jensen and Superintendent, Robert Bubach.

DeShawn Tofsrud moved to approve the agenda with additions. Motion was seconded by Kim Nelsen and approved by Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and DeShawn Tofsrud.

DeShawn Tofsrud moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of April 24, May 9 with corrections and May 14, 2018, minutes, bills, May financial reports and 2017-2018 Pupil Membership report. Motion was seconded by Tyson Follman and approved by Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and DeShawn Tofsrud.

Jeff Jacobson moved to pursue the Early Childhood Education grant for the 18-19 school year for the intent of aiding the Pre-K program. Grant funds would be for eligible free and reduced 4 year olds in the program. Motion was seconded by Tyson Follman and approved by Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and DeShawn Tofsrud.

Tyson Follman moved to hire Sherry Olson as English teacher. Motion was seconded by Kim Nelsen and approved by Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and DeShawn Tofsrud.

Tyson Follman moved to accept the tuition agreement for the Minnewaukan School District student for 2018-2019 and the open enrollment for 2019-2020. Motion was seconded by Jeff Jacobson and approved by Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and DeShawn Tofsrud.

Tyson Follman moved to accept the election results as follows: There were 108 votes cast, Kim Nelsen received 85; Eric Haagenon received 11, Pete Ritterman received 3, 7 others received 7 votes, and one voided vote. Kim Nelsen was declared the elected School Board member for a term of 3 years. Motion was seconded by Jeff Jacobson and approved by Randy Gunderson, Tyson Follman, Jeff Jacobson, Kim Nelsen and DeShawn Tofsrud.

Next regular meeting is scheduled for July 10, 2018, at 6:30 p.m.

Discussion was held on Ag Ed; Drivers' Ed; and a used BB hoop from outside basketball court will be placed in the elementary playground.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
