

Benson County Wildcats Indoor Event Information & Recommendations

Leeds Public School Facility

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and in order to comply with the ND Smart Restart guidelines to provide a safer experience and environment for athletes, spectators, and event staff, the following guidelines will be used at sporting events hosted at Leeds Public School.

Masks/Face coverings are required when entering the school and while in the hallways. Once in the stand these can be removed if you so choose. Social distancing is recommended. Please respect the choices of those seated around you. Attendees should stay home if they have any symptoms of COVID-19.

Though Leeds Public School has taken the necessary precautions following CDC and local health department guidelines, we cannot guarantee an environment that is entirely free of COVID-19. Those with underlying health conditions or COVID-19 concerns should consider the risks prior to attending a sporting event.

ATTENDANCE:

- Attendance to games will change depending on the phase of the county.
- Current county phase: Yellow
 - The following measures will be taken to control capacity:
 - Visiting Team:
 - A minimum of 4 game tickets per player will be sent to the visiting school's AD to distribute. We would like to keep ticket availability to player's parents, grandparents, and/or family members.
 - Home Team:
 - A minimum of 4 game tickets per player will be given to each player on the team. We would like to keep ticket availability to player's parents, grandparents, and/or family members.
 - Student Body:
 - Students in grades 7 – 12 from Leeds or Maddock will be allowed to attend.
 - No PreK – 6 students unless with a parent. Both parent and PreK – 6 students must have a season pass or both must have a player distributed ticket. These students need to be seated in the bleachers with their parents and be accompanied by a parent if in the halls.

- General Public:
 - The game is closed to the general public. ONLY those individuals with a player distributed game ticket or an individual with a Benson County Wildcats season sport pass will be allowed to attend the game.
- No congregating or lingering after the game. All Players, parents, and spectators are asked to leave immediately following the game.

ADMISSION:

- Prices: Adults: \$6.00 Students: \$4.00
- Exact change is encouraged.
- Those presenting a ticket or pass at gate entrance will pay at that time.
- There will be no admission fee for elementary and JH games therefore those attending these games will be asked to leave immediately following the game.

CONCESSIONS:

- Limited food menu will be available
- Pop, water, candy, and popcorn available
- Personnel will wear masks and gloves and will distribute all condiments to the customers.
- Exact change is encouraged.

LOCKER ROOMS:

- Available for visiting teams
- Coaches to monitor their own teams.
- Recommending 10 player maximum in locker rooms at a given time
- Disinfecting spray and supplies will be provided and encouraged to be used.

GAME VIEWING/STREAMING OPTIONS:

- Live, online streams of varsity events will be ATTEMPTED for those unable to attend in person. Link will be shared with the AD once established for the night.
